- From July 22, for three weeks, 24 hours/day, the A4119 will be closed to through traffic from Radyr to Groesfaen.
  - Cyclists and pedestrians will be able to get through.
  - All A4119 traffic coming out of Cardiff will be diverted at Radyr onto Heol Isaf.
  - At the RCT end all traffic for Cardiff will be diverted to the M4.
- Residents living off the A4119 will be able to get to their roads from either of these points but the big goal is to stop all through traffic.
  - The official diversion route will be the A48.
  - Advance warning signs will go up 2 weeks before July 22.
